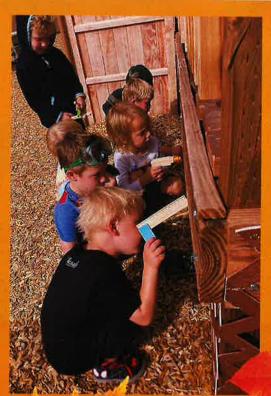

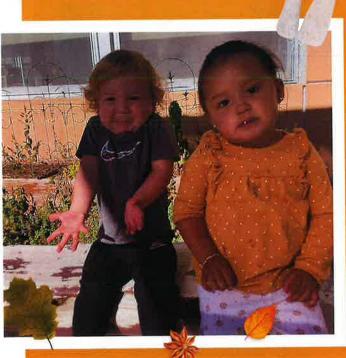

How to Reduce Power Struggles



Are you tired of constant arguments when it's time for your child to wear a coat, tidy up, or brush their teeth?



Here are some things you can do to really make a difference:

Set Non-Negotiables:

Start by defining a list of "non-negotiables." These are the essential tasks that your child must complete, like brushing their teeth. Everything else can be a gradual work in progress. Remember, your child needs to be able to assert themselves and say no, so give them that space.

Offer Choices:

Instead of commanding your child to do something, provide options. For instance, ask, "Do you want to clean up by yourself, or would you like some help?" This approach empowers your child by giving them a sense of control while still conveying your expectations.

Find Mutual Wins:

Explore solutions where both you and your child can win. When facing resistance, ask, "How can we both win in this situation?" For example, if getting dressed for school is a struggle, consider allowing your child to choose their outfit the night before and wear it to bed. This approach might create a compromise that eliminates morning battles.

Encourage Open Communication:

Sometimes, it helps to ask your child why they're reluctant to do something. Give them a chance to express themselves without judgment. There could be underlying reasons they're not sharing. By listening, you show that you care and respect their feelings.

Maintain Connection:

Remember, our parenting rules have good intentions, but power struggles can hinder progress. Focus on staying connected with your child. Aim for solutions that strengthen your bond and allow you both to achieve your goals.

Option 2: Veterans Affairs in Salida at 719-539-3803 to schedule a medical ride. Veterans only.

Option 3: Upper Arkansas Area Agency on Aging at 719-539-3341. Assistance with transportation to medical appointments. Mileage is paid to driver of client's choice, up to \$200.00. In order to remain in compliance with program requirements, a copy of the driver's insurance and license is needed.

Option 1: Call <u>Chaffee Shuttle</u> at **719-530-8980**. Call the dispatcher at least 24 hours in advance (preferably 48 hours in advance or more) during office hours. Rides are available on a first-come, first-served basis. Dispatcher Hours: Monday to Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.

Option 2: Call <u>MedRide</u> at 719-545-3333 or <u>www.medridecolorado.com</u> Requires 24-48 hours advance notice to schedule.

Option 3: Call or text **Yana Transportation** at **720-298-7207** or visit **yananemt.com**. 24/7 non emergent transportation for medical rides to appointments outside of Chaffee County.

Option 4: Schedule with IntelliRide. Visit gointelliride.com/colorado for scheduling, or call 719-766-4660

Option 5: Call **Grace Ride** at **719-569-0302**. Available 7 days a week for medical appointments. Preferred 24 hours in advance.

Getting Around Chaffee County (non-medical appointments)

The Chaffee Shuttle is a nonprofit shared ride and public transit service with both fixed bus routes and door-to-door services throughout Chaffee County.

Door-to-Door Service: Available in Chaffee County only. Call the dispatcher at least 24 hours in advance (preferably 48 hours in advance or more) during office hours. Shuttle Hours: Monday to Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. / Saturdays by request. Dispatcher Hours: Monday to Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. / 719-530-8980
