

Home Based Programs

SECC Home Visit Program

- Services are provided prenatally as well as for families with children from birth to three years old.
- Topics include prenatal health, social emotional development, physical and brain development, language, literacy, basic care, play, family culture, and stress management.
- Weekly visits consist of activities and support based on your child's current development and your family's interests.
- Home visits continue until your child is eligible to enter the Center based program, and your family feels ready.
